**Please make sure your child's name is clearly labelled.**



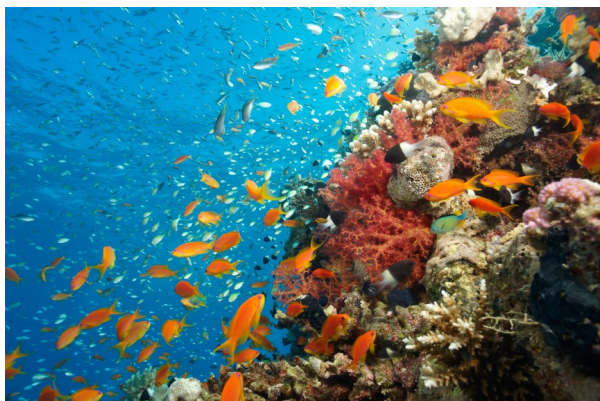
## Nursery Preview Learning

## Reception Preview Learning

### Topic
